



Job Description: The Predistribution Initiative (PDI) is looking for a full-time Senior Associate to work closely with our Leadership Team on programming, strategy, and execution.

About Us

The [Predistribution Initiative](#) (PDI) is a US-based non-profit working with institutional investors and their stakeholders globally to shift investment structures and practices in ways that share more wealth and influence with workers and communities. We believe this is the most promising path to address societal risks, including inequality, climate change, and biodiversity loss. PDI takes a non-partisan approach, with a core belief that reducing socio-economic inequality can reduce polarization and conflict.

The Senior Associate Position

PDI seeks a talented full-time Senior Associate to work on operational, strategic and research functions directly with our leadership team. The Senior Associate will report to our Executive Director and can be based anywhere in the world where it is reasonable to have calls and virtual meetings during business hours in the Eastern Standard time zone. Limited travel is anticipated. The scope will include:

- Project Execution
 - Leading research, both qualitative and quantitative
 - Drafting project reports and presentations
 - Mapping and managing relationships with a broad range of stakeholders (including but not limited to asset owners and allocators, asset managers, companies, civil society, labour advocates, and academics) through one-on-one engagements, convenings, and network communications

 - Maintaining budgets and developing financial reports
 - Developing a social media strategy
 - Coordinating PDI's transition to an independent 501c3
 - Representing PDI in meetings and at periodic events and convenings
 - Supporting logistical and operational matters
- Business Development
 - Supporting PDI's Executive Director in designing new projects
 - Drafting fundraising materials and participating in presentations
 - Supporting the development of partnerships and activities with other organizations, consultants, and service providers
